Pedro Noguera, PhD, is a professor in the Steinhardt School of Culture, Education, and Human Development at New York University. He is also the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Center for Urban Education and the co-Director of the Institute for the study of Globalization and Education in Metropolitan Settings (IGEMS). An urban sociologist, Noguera’s scholarship and research focuses on the ways in which schools are influenced by social and economic conditions in the urban environment

Dr. De Jesús' is an Assistant Professor at Hunter College School of Social Work. His research focuses on addressing the social and cultural barriers, which prevent Latino and African American students from accessing post secondary educational experiences and successfully transitioning to higher education.
